Things to consider...

- **Home/Office Visits:** we request that all pregnant or mothers of newborns participate in 3 free home/office visits
- **Insurance:** we bill Medicaid/private insurance, if you don't qualify for either we suggest a \$20 donation

The Casper-Natrona County Health Department follows the recommendation of the World Health Organization: Exclusive breastfeeding up to 6 months of age, with continued breastfeeding along with appropriate complementary foods up to two years of age or beyond. Most babies should be breastfed for at least 12 months
