Temporary Body Art Permit Requirements

Temporary permits may be issued for body art services provided outside the physical site of a licensed facility for the purpose of educational, trade show or demonstration purposes only. Temporary permits are not transferable from one location and/or person to another and may not exceed fourteen (14) calendar days. Applications for temporary permits must be submitted to the department at least thirty (30) days prior to the event.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Applications provided by the department must be completed.
- 2. To scale floor plans of the temporary facility indicating locations of work stations and hand sinks are required.
- 3. Copies of client forms and after care instructions must be submitted for review.
- 4. Evidence of spore test performed on sterilization equipment thirty (30) days or less prior to the date of the event if single use, prepackaged, sterilized equipment is not in use.
- 5. Submit a fee of \$50.00 to the department.

Technician Requirements:

- 1. Applicant must be affiliated with a permanent facility which is permitted by the Casper-Natrona County Health Department and
- 2. Applicant must have a current operator permit from the Casper-Natrona County Health Department.

Or

- 1. Applicant must obtain an operators permit from the Casper-Natrona County Health Department by submitting the following information:
 - a. Operator permit application supplied by the department
 - b. Proof of attendance at a blood borne pathogen training program
 - c. Demonstration of knowledge on facility safety and sanitation through documentation of attendance of approved training courses from American Red Cross, US OSHA or professional body art organizations or
 - d. Successful completion of an examination given by the department.
- 2. Submit a fee of \$50.00 to the department

Temporary Establishment Requirements

1. Conveniently located handwashing facilities with liquid soap, paper towels and hot and cold water.

- 2. Tuberculocidal single use hand wipes to augment hand washing must be available at each station.
- 3. Minimum of eighty (80) square feet of floor space.
- 4. At least one hundred (100) foot candles of light at the level where the body art procedure is being performed.
- 5. Facilities to properly sterilize equipment or use of single use, prepackaged, sterilized equipment only.
- 6. Ability to clean and sanitize the area used for body art procedures.

Mobile Facility Requirements:

- 1. Facilities must be completely enclosed vehicle such as a trailer or motor home. No body art procedures shall be performed outside of the enclosed vehicle; no open air work stations or tents will be approved.
- 2. Facilities must meet the following minimum requirements:
 - a. Establishment must be clean and sanitary at all times
 - b. No habitation or food preparation is permitted inside the vehicle.
 - c. Hand washing facilities with hot and cold water must be available. An adequate supply of potable water shall be maintained at all times during operation.
 - d. Tuberculocidal single use hand wipes to augment hand washing must be available.
 - e. Liquid waste storage tanks must be 20% greater than the capacity of the onboard potable water supply.
 - f. Restroom facilities must be available with separate handsink within the restroom cubicle.

Once the permits are issued but prior to any body art procedure being performed, the department must inspect the facility.
