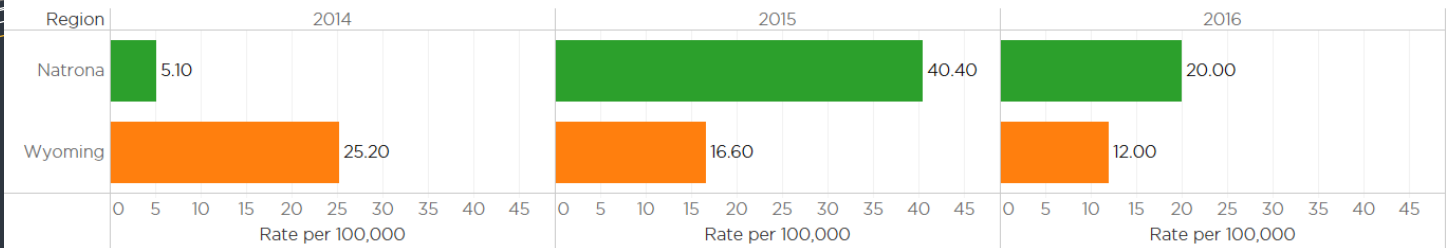

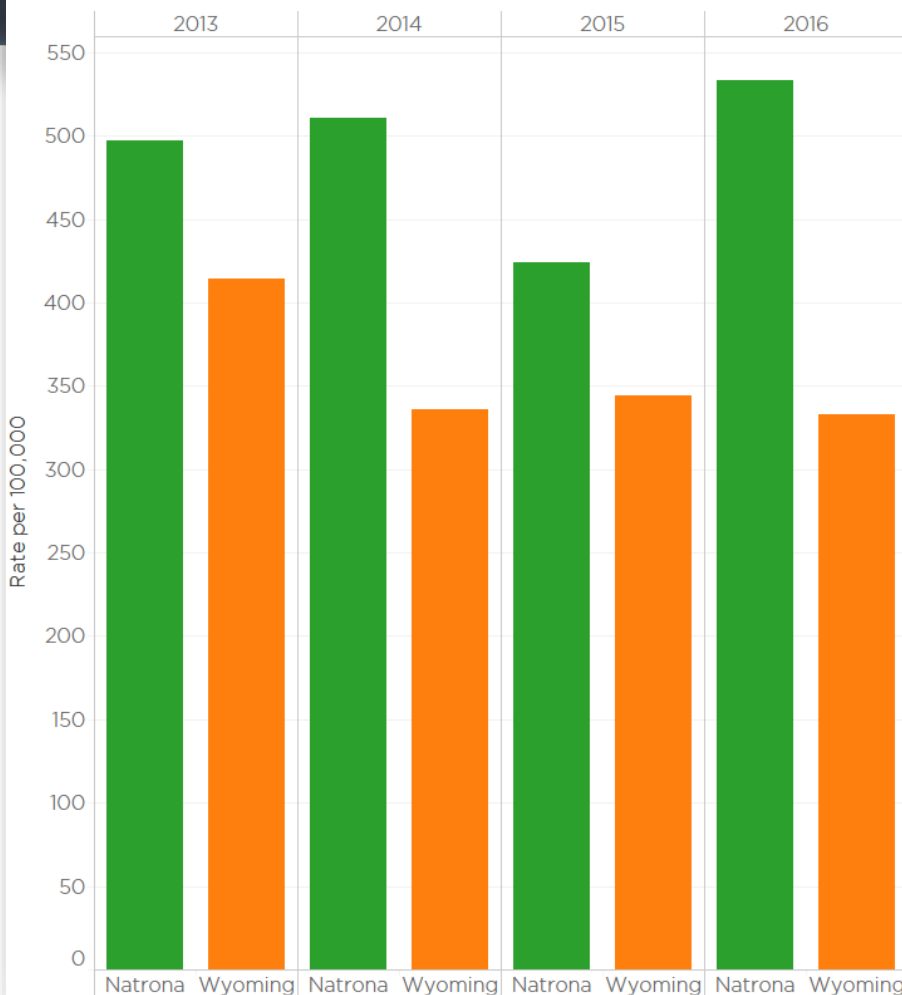

Youth Drunkenness Arrests

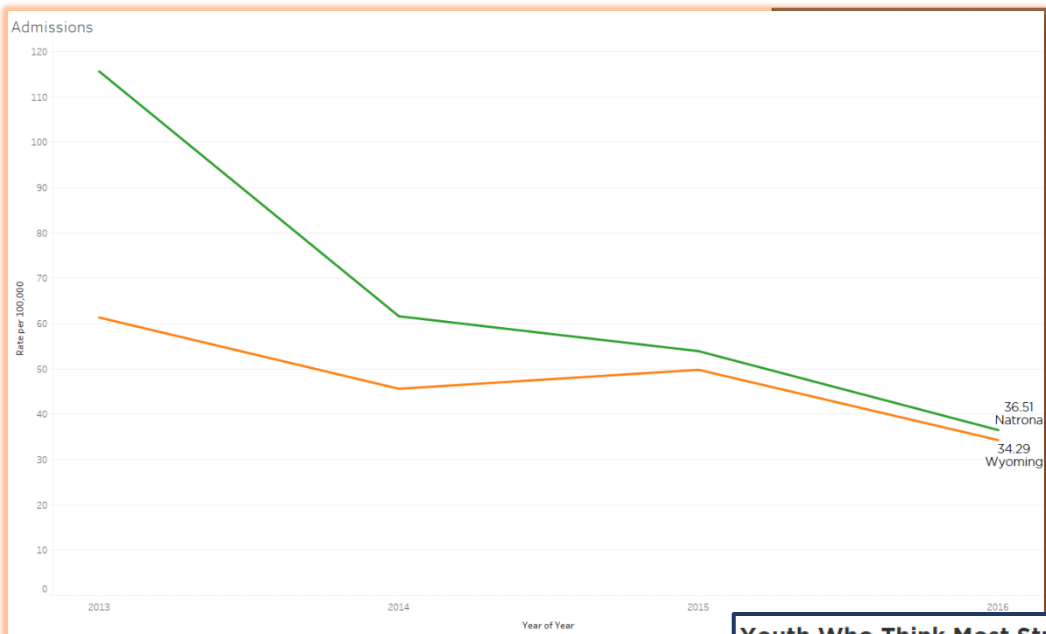
- Youth drunkenness arrests recently spiked in 2015 and 2016 for Natrona County
- Natrona County has a higher rate of youth drunkenness arrests than Wyoming
- In 2015, **40.4** per 100,000 youth were arrested for youth drunkenness

Youth Liquor Law Violations



- Natrona continually has a higher rate of youth liquor law violations per 100,000
- In 2016, there was an increase in youth liquor law violations with **533** violations per 100,000
- 2016 had the highest rate of youth liquor law violations since 2012

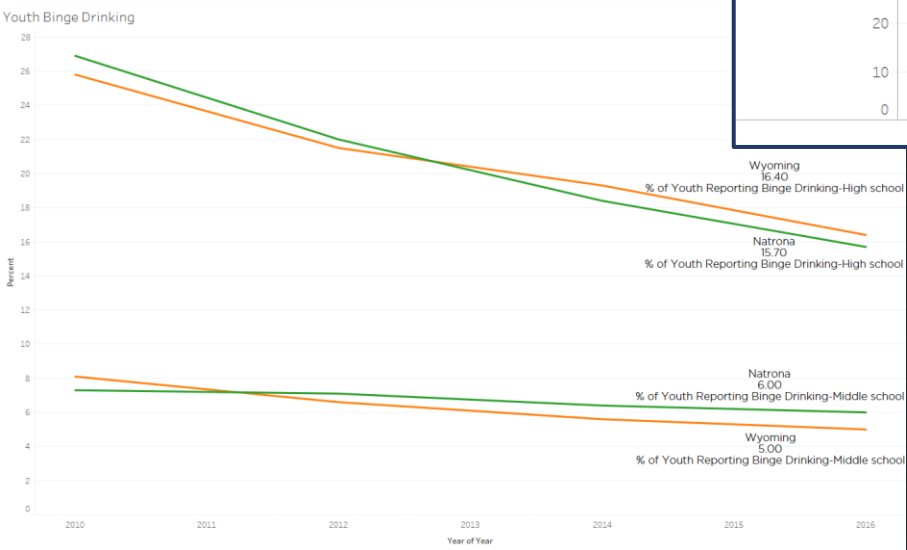
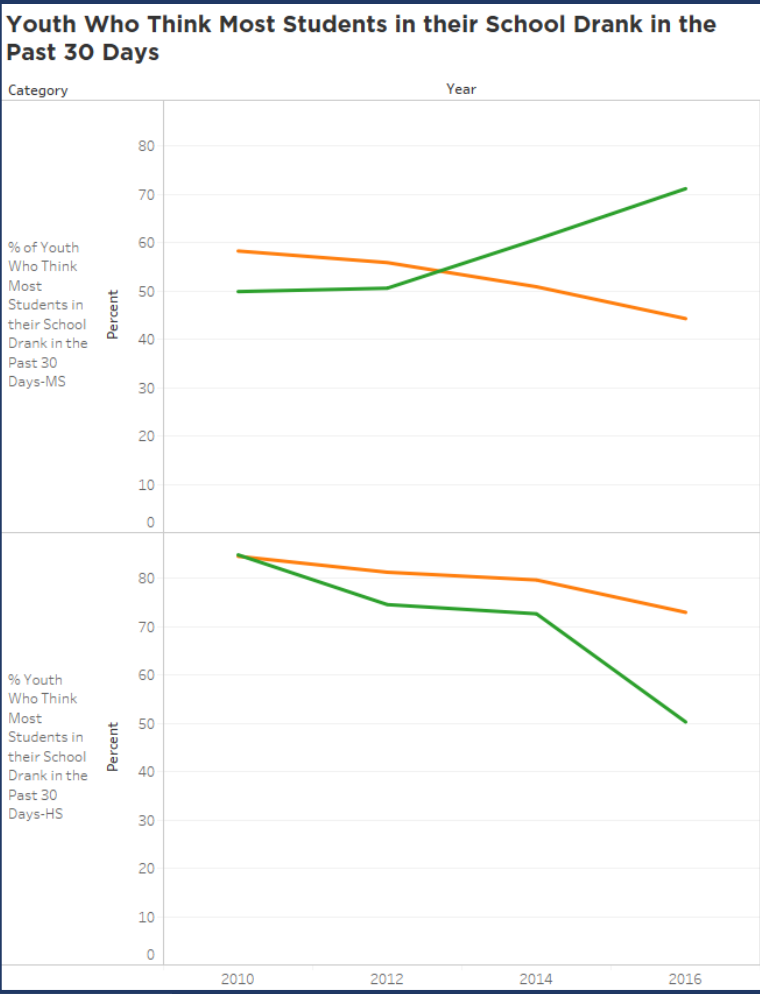


- Treatment admissions with primary presenting problem of alcohol are continuously above the Wyoming admissions rate for Natrona County
- In 2016, admissions with primary presenting problem of alcohol was **36.51** per 100,000

- **71.2%** of middle school students think most students in their school drank in the past 30 days
- The rate of Natrona County middle school students who think most students in their school drank in the past 30 days is over **25%** higher than Wyoming
